Dormant Accounts: Stay Active, Stay Connected



Did you know that your account can be classified as dormant if there's no member-initiated activity for a prolonged period? Dormant accounts may be subject to service charges and can make it harder for you to access your funds when needed.

- Make at least one transaction annually (such as a deposit, withdrawal, or transfer)
- Sign in to CUOnline to monitor your account and avoid dormant fees.
- Set a calendar reminder to review your account activity regularly.
- Contact us if you're unsure of your status—we're happy to help.

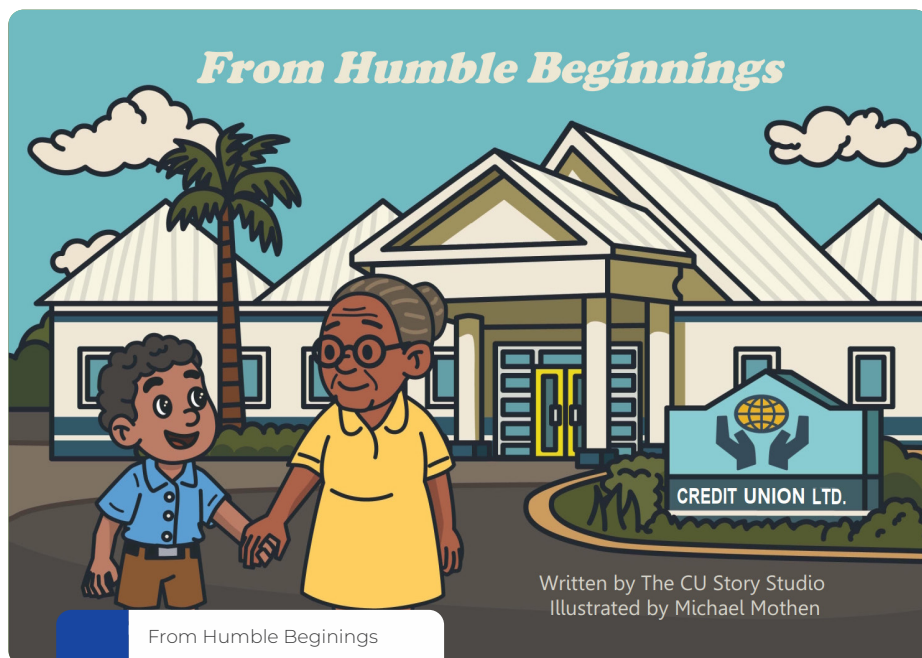


Cayman Islands Netball Association

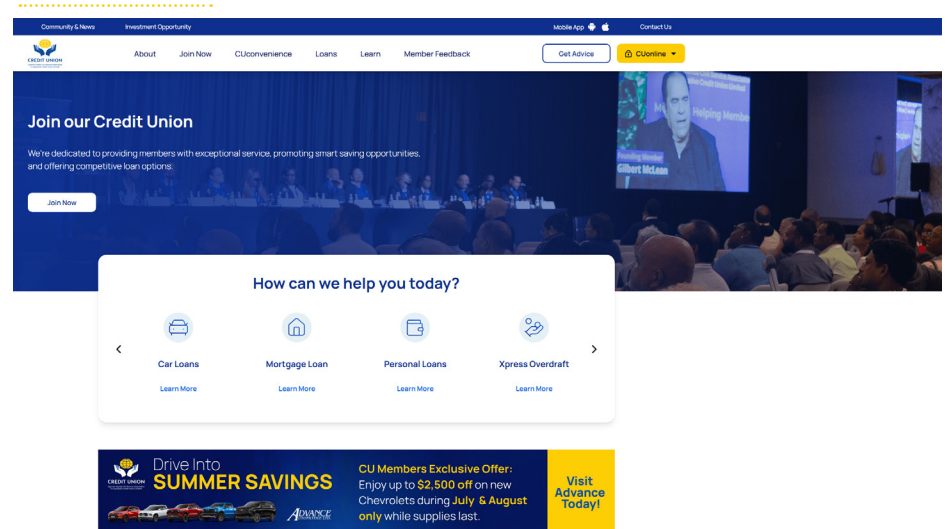
As part of our 50th Anniversary celebrations, we're planting 50 trees for 50 years in partnership with the National Trust—another way we're growing together, for generations to come.
